Horizontal and vertical locking devices. Light movement is frictioned dampened for ease of operation.


Rubber covered wiring cable with water-tight fittings.

INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS: Searchlight should be mounted so base is level. Drill 1" (25.4 mm) clearance hole through roof for outside control rod. Drill 34" (19 mm) diameter hole for wiring 2" (51 mm) toward the aft from the center hole. Remove roll pin (Key 25) from control handle using 3/16" (5 mm) punch. Remove control handle (Key 24), pivot bearing (Key 21), control rod bracket (Key 20) and nut (Key 22). Loosen 2 set screws (Key 19) and 2 set screws (Key 7) and remove fulcrum (Key 8) from outside control rod. Light is now ready to be installed on deck. Insert control rod and cable through clearance holes. With the cable connector on the base toward the aft end. locate and mark the 4 mounting holes in the base. Remove the searchlight and drill 4 starter holes for #8 wood screws as marked. Place gasket (Key 29) on mounting surface and line up holes in gasket with mounting holes just drilled. Insert searchlight and cable through clearance holes and secure to deck with 4 mounting screws provided (Key 31). Note: On irregular surface or curved surfaces, a sealing compound should be placed on both sides of the gasket to insure a water-tight seal. From inside

the cabin, slide escutcheon plate (Key 30) over control rod and mark 4 mounting hole locations on ceiling. Remove escutcheon plate and drill 4 starter holes for #8 wood screws as marked. Attach escutcheon plate to ceiling using 4 mounting screws provided (Key 31). Replace fulcrum, nut, control rod bracket, pivot bearing, control handle and roll pin, in that order. Control handle should face aft when searchlight is facing forward. To adjust alignment, loosen nut (Key 15) and rotate control handle and fulcrum assembly until lined up with searchlight head. Retighten nut. Caution! Do not overtighten set screws (Key 7) in fulcrum. These specially designed set screws provide a guide for the fulcrum for horizontal movement of the searchlight, and, therefore, are not intended to lock tight against the control rod. Excessive drag and possible damage to the set screw could result from overtightening. Drag for the horizontal movement can be adjusted according to the operator's feel by tightening the top adjusting knob (Key 18). Likewise, drag for the vertical movement can be adjusted by tightening the bottom adjusting knob (Key 18)

WIRING INSTRUCTIONS: Use 12 gauge stranded copper wire for up to 35′ (10.6 ·m). For greater distances, use 10 gauge stranded copper wire. Use a switch with an amperage rating of no less than the amperage of the searchlight (see chart). The green lead in the cable is intended for D.C. bonding (grounding) of the searchlight.


CHANGING BULB: Make sure power is off. Remove bulb clamp ring and remove bulb, disconnecting wires from rear of bulb. After connecting wires securely to replacement bulb, (see chart on reverse side) install bulb in housing and replace clamp ring. Before tightening clamp, position bulb top indicator to top center of housing. Turn unit on to test.

MAINTENANCE: Clean the bulb periodically with a soft, lint free cloth for best efficiency. Apply a coat of all-weather grease to all moving parts as needed. Periodically check bolts and set screws for tightness.

CAUTION NOTE: After extended periods of use, the searchlight housing and bulb become very hot. Caution should be used when working around light or when changing bulb to prevent possible minor burns.
